STEPS TO FOLLOW WHEN CONSTRUCTING A SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING:

Please call **465-8399** or stop by the **One Stop Permit Center** for information regarding the following:

- 1. Check to see if a single-family home is permitted on the property.
- 2. Every application for a single-family residential zoning authorization permit to construct, move, alter, or change the type of use must provide an 8 ½ x 11 inch or 8 ½ x 14 inch drawing, prepared to scale, showing the footprints of proposed and existing buildings or structures.

- 3. Obtain a Zoning Authorization Permit.
- 4. Obtain a Authorization to Construct (septic tank permit) and well permit, if applicable.

- 6. Contact the Building Inspectors regarding inspections.

STEPS TO FOLLOW WHEN CONSTRUCTING A TWO-FAMILY (DUPLEX) DWELLING:

Please call **465-8399** or stop by the **One Stop Permit Center** for information regarding the following:

- 1. Check to see if a two-family dwelling is permitted on the property.
- 2. Talk with someone from the Catawba County Planning Department regarding the specific regulations that apply to two-family dwellings. Some examples are parking, watershed or planned development rezoning when 3 or more units are proposed.
- 3. Every application for a residential zoning authorization permit to construct, move, alter, or change the type of use must provide an 8 ½ x 11 inch or 8 ½ x 14 inch drawing, prepared to scale, showing the footprints of proposed and existing buildings or structures.
